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
Internship

Overview:

In tight collaboration with ABL networked prominent Universities/enterprises/governmental institutions in each country, ABL implements the following two types of internships:

- 1) on-site internship which the ABL researchers (i.e. interns) do internship at the host companies in selected country.
- 2) International Cyber Lab on-line

The ABL internship enables the interns to build close relationship with enterprises, governmental institutions and dramatically improves their ability to develop business in the country.
